NATIVE AMERICAN –CENSUS– GENERAL 1885-1940

Indian Census Rolls, 1885-1940.

These census rolls were usually submitted each year by agents or superintendents in charge of Indian reservations, as required by an act of July 4, 1884 (23 Stat. 98). The data on the rolls vary to some extent, but usually given are the English and/or Indian name of the person, roll number, age or date of birth, sex, and relationship to head of family. Beginning in 1930, the rolls also show the degree of Indian blood, marital status, ward status, place of residence, and sometimes other information. For certain years—including 1935, 1936, 1938, and 1939—only supplemental rolls of additions and deletions were compiled. Most of the 1940 rolls have been retained by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and are not included in this publication.

There is not a census for every reservation or group of Indians for every year. Only persons who maintained a formal affiliation with a tribe under Federal supervision are listed on these census rolls.

NATIVE AMERICAN –ENROLLMENT

Enrollment Cards of the Five Civilized Tribes, 1898-1914.

This microfilm publication reproduces the enrollment cards prepared by the staff of the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes (Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Creek, and Seminole) between 1898 and 1914. These records are part of the Records of the Office of Indian Affairs, Record Group 75, and are housed in the Archives Branch of the Federal Archives and Records Center, Fort Worth, Texas.

The Commission enrolled individuals as “citizens” of a tribe under the following categories: Citizens by Blood, Citizens by Marriage, New Born Citizens by Blood (enrolled under an act of Congress approved March 3, 1905, 33 Stat. 1071), Minor Citizens by Blood (enrolled under an act of Congress approved April 26, 1906, 34 Stat. 137), Freedmen (former black slaves of Indians, later freed and admitted to tribal citizenship), New Born Freedmen, and Minor Freedmen. Delaware Indians adopted by the Cherokee tribe were enrolled as a separate group within the Cherokee. Within each enrollment category, the Commission generally maintained three types of cards: “Straight” cards for persons whose applications were approved, “D” cards for persons whose applications were considered doubtful and subject to question, and “R” cards for persons whose applications were rejected. Persons listed on “D” cards were subsequently transferred to either “Straight” or “R” cards depending on the Commission’s decisions. All decisions of the Commission were sent to the Secretary of the Interior for final approval.

An enrollment card, sometimes referred to by the Commission as a “census card,” records the information provided by individual applications submitted by members of the same family group or household and includes notation of the actions taken. The information given for each applicant includes name, roll number (individual’s number if enrolled), age, sex, degree of Indian blood, relationship to the head of the family group, parents’ names, and references to enrollment on earlier rolls used by the Commission for verification of eligibility. The card often includes references to kin-related enrollment cards and notations about births, deaths, changes in marital status, and actions taken by the Commission and the Secretary of the Interior. Within each enrollment category, the cards are arranged numerically by a “field” or “census card” number which is separate from the roll

number. The index to the final rolls, which is reproduced on roll 1 of this publication, provides the roll number for each person, while the final rolls themselves provide the census card numbers for each enrollee. No indexes have been located for the majority of the “D” and “R” cards. There are a few Mississippi Choctaw “Identified” and “Field Cards” as well as some Chickasaw “Canceled” that refer to persons never finally enrolled.

In 1916 Roblin was instructed to enumerate and enroll unattached Indians of western Washington. His report and a roll of such

Indians arranged by tribes and by families has been filmed on the first roll of this microfilm publication. The applications and

evidence submitted to him and his recommendations and decisions have been filmed immediately following the roll.

Persons who wished to be recognized as Indians and to be granted land allotments submitted applications to Special Agent Roblin. The tribal groupings on Roblin's roll are not arranged in any discernable order, although the names of the families belonging to each tribe usually are arranged in a rough alphabetical order. For this publication, the applications and evidence are grouped together by tribe and arranged in strict alphabetical order by the name of the tribe. A copy of the pertinent section of the Roblin roll has been filmed before the records relating to each tribe. Under each tribal grouping the records relating to families are arranged in strict alphabetical order by the name of the head of the family. Within each family grouping, the records relating to family members are arranged alphabetically by the surname of the individual, which sometimes differs from that of the head of the family. At the end of some of the tribal groupings are applications received from persons who already were enrolled at same Indian agency although they might not have been allotted at that agency. Special Agent Roblin reported that he had not placed the names of such persons on this roll.

Many applicants previously had applied for adoption by the Quinaielt Indians after an act of Congress of March 4, 1911, authorized the allotment of the Quinaielt Reservation, but the Bureau of Indian Affairs had questioned the validity of their applications. Roblin also was instructed to investigate the adoption applications. Cross-reference sheets in this publication indicate that records relating to a specific family will also be found among the Quinaielt adoption records. The Quinaielt adoption applications have been microfilmed as M1344, *Records Concerning Applications for Adoption by the Quinaielt Indians, 1910-19*.
