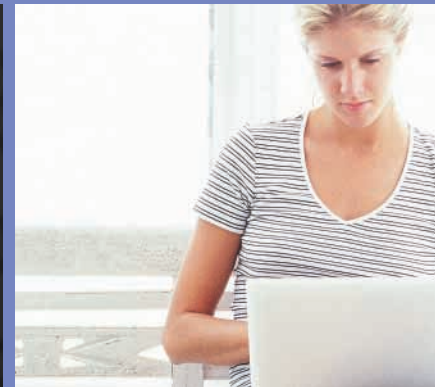

Periodicals Archive Online offers enhanced access to existing multidisciplinary Collections I-VI —two 100-title collections, and four 75-title collections. All titles have been carefully selected from 5,000 titles in Periodicals Index Online by an international advisory board of librarians.

- Researchers get full-image, cover-to-cover access for the full run of the journal through 1995. Since Collection III, PAO has featured fully searchable ASCII full text for each page image and hit-term highlighting. Searchable full text and hit-term highlighting are being added for earlier collections on a retrospective basis.
 - Besides the wide array of scholarly titles, Periodicals Archive Online boasts an impressive number of hard-to-find works from the 19th century. Periodicals Archive Online is unique in its international coverage and foreign-language content. Titles in languages other than English constitute 20% of the journals. Substantial coverage is offered for titles in Spanish, German, Italian, and French, and a number of multilingual titles are also included. In fact, if you were to put all the issues found in Periodicals Archive Online on a shelf, you would need more than a mile of shelf space.

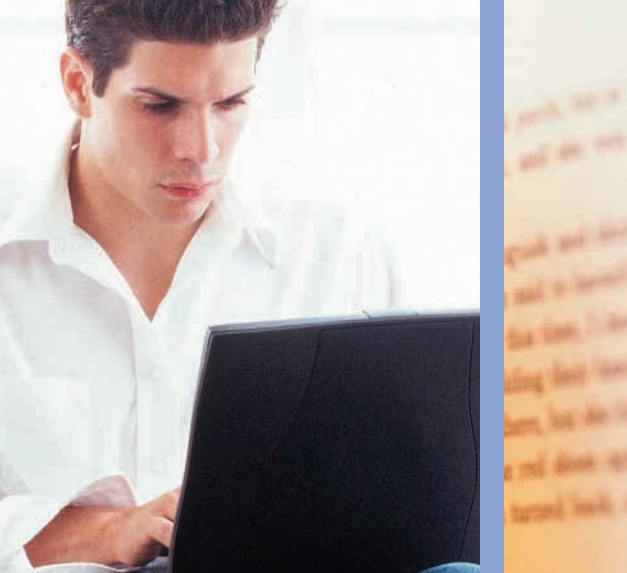
